Weather conditions exhibited a dramatic shift in wind direction as the morning progressed (S to NW). Winds pushing toward shore early produced high counts for species such as Black-legged Kittiwake and Dovekie. On the land bird side of the ledger, Northern Cardinal (9) is a high count for this CBC historically.
